- Grown in the Foothills of the Rocky Mountains in Alberta, Canada. Albertan hay is some of the most palatable hay in the world
- **Increased sugar content** in our **Timothy** hay is the result of higher altitudes and our northern location, which makes for long, warm days and cool nights during the growing season.
- High protein content and our excellent growing conditions make our Alfalfa hay desirable for diary producers worldwide.



HARVESTING, PROCESSING AND QUALITY CONTROL

The majority of our hay is **produced on our own farms** and the rest we purchase from trusted producers who follow our growing protocols and adhere to our quality control standards.

TIMOTHY

Dryland Timothy hay is cut once per season, while irrigated Timothy is harvested 2 times per season.

Timothy hay, is graded by observation of texture, color and smell.





NON-GMO ALFALFA

Dryland **non-GMO** Alfalfa hay is cut up to 3 times per season, while irrigated alfalfa may be harvested up to 4 times per season.

Alfalfa hay is graded by independent laboratory analysis.

MIXED HAY

Our mixed hay crop is grown on dryland as well as irrigation. It is a versatile crop which combines non-GMO Alfalfa, Timothy, Orchard hay, Fescue hay and Brome hay.
